

Pandemic Plan

The Bank of Orrick has been developing and updating our Disaster Recovery and Pandemic Plans for several years. We understand that the well-being of our customers and employees is key in serving the needs of our community during uncertain times like we are currently experiencing.

Some of the elements of our Pandemic Response Plan include the following.

- 1) Increased cleaning and sanitation schedule for the bank. We have increased the cleaning schedule for the bank from three times per week to 5 times per week.
- 2) Emphasis on the part of the staff to follow healthy habits during the day including increased hand washing and interim cleaning of work areas during the day.
- 3) Actively monitoring the coronavirus situation. We look to www.coronavirus.gov as an up to date source of information and encourage our customers to go to this site should they need up to date information.

At this time the Bank of Orrick lobby remains open and we have no plans to close it. We do suggest that you make an appointment if the nature of your business requires in person contact with bank staff.
